How to Link a Registration

Why do you need to Link a Registration?

For new Brands Online Portal users with existing registrations, you will need to link your existing registration to your portal account before you can access applications such as Reregistrations and Notifications of Change of Details.

When do you need to Link a Registration?

- If you are a first-time user of the Brands Online Portal, you must first link your registration before you can process any Re-registration applications or a Notification of Change of Address and Property Details.
- If you have multiple registrations (Beekeeper, Buyer Identification Code, Livestock, Non-Farming Property Operator), you may need to link each registration you hold depending on if they are under the same owner.

For example, if you have registered as a livestock owner and this is the first time you are using the portal, after logging on, complete the Link A Registration process using information relevant to that registration. If you hold other registration types with DPIRD, (e.g. as a beekeeper), you must perform Link your Registration using information relevant to each registration.

When are you not required to Link a Registration?

If you are a new registrant, having no previous registrations with DPIRD, you will not need to link a registration after you have logged on. You can simply apply for your new registration.

Information required to Link a Registration

The following information is required to complete the process to Link a Registration.

- Registered Owner ID (all registration types) this is found on your first Notice of Re-registration/Renewal or your Certificate of Registration (for newer certificates). It may be called the Reference number on older documents.
- Property Identification Code (for livestock or non-farming owners) found on your PIC card.
- Buyer Identification Code (for BIC owners) found on your BIC card.
- Hive Brand (for beekeepers) found on your hive brand card.
