## NOTIFICATION OF IMPORT OF PRESCRIBED POTENTIAL CARRIER (SOIL) CONSIGNED TO A QUARANTINE FACILITY IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

The import requirements published in accordance with Regulation 72 of the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013 allow for soil as a prescribed potential carrier to be imported to a quarantine facility in Western Australia for the purpose of scientific analysis.

Each consignment must be accompanied by this notification form.
