

BIOSECURITY AND AGRICULTURE MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS 2013

NOTIFICATION OF IMPORT OF PRESCRIBED POTENTIAL CARRIERS (HONEY BEE PRODUCTS AND EQUIPMENT) CONSIGNED TO AN APPROVED QUARANTINE FACILITY IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

The import requirements published in accordance with Regulation 72 of the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013* allows for prescribed potential carriers) to be imported to an approved quarantine facility in Western Australia for the purposes of disease diagnostics or analysis.

Each consignment imported must be accompanied by this notification form.
