

# **Service Provider Directory**

To assess the feasibility of carbon farming into existing and proposed business activities, landholders require professional advice on how to integrate carbon farming into their business and register with the Clean Energy Regulator (CER). There are also emerging opportunities like insetting and biodiversity credits that landholders should seek professional advice on as well.

DPIRD advises anyone new to the carbon market and the Australian Carbon Credit Unit (ACCU) Scheme to seek professional advice regarding the technical and regulatory aspects of running a carbon farming project.

Independent expert advice can be obtained from carbon service providers, agribusiness advisors, agronomists, environmental consultants, financial and legal advisors. Other landowners may wish to access a carbon service provider that can provide an end-to-end service with in-house specialists.

### **Qualifications and Experience**

Professional Service Providers active in the carbon industry offer a range of expertise. The type of provider will depend on the carbon farming project and your enterprise size and complexity.

Landholders should undertake their own due diligence by checking the provider's credentials and getting several quotes. To assist, the following qualifications and questions can be considered before engaging with a service provider.

#### **Carbon Farming Project Development and Management**

- Is the carbon project developer a signatory to the <u>Australian Carbon Industry Code of Conduct</u>?

  The Carbon Market Institute administers the Australian Carbon Industry Code of Conduct. They list all current signatories on their webpage.
- Anyone giving financial advice (e.g. ACCU price, trading options, investment strategies etc) must hold a <u>Australian Financial Services Licence</u> (AFSL).
  - The Australian Securities and Investments Commission is responsible for administering the AFSL regime and keeps a searchable professional register of all AFSL holders.
- Can the Project Developer provide examples of projects they successfully established with other landholders like you? Can you talk to them?
- Do they have up-to-date software and mapping capabilities?

#### **Agribusiness Advisors and Agronomists**

- Is the advisor a member of the Australian Association of Agricultural Consultants of WA (AAAC [WA])?
  - A <u>list of consultants</u> and their area of expertise is found on the AAAC [WA] website.
- Does your agronomist have suitable qualifications and experience?

#### **Environmental and Revegetation Consultants**

• Is the consultant a member of the Environmental Consultants Association (WA) Inc. (ECA) or the Revegetation Industry Association of WA?

The Environmental Consultants Association (WA) Inc. is the lead professional body representing commercial environmental consultants throughout Western Australia. It provides a list of 160 registered consultants to <u>search via their area of expertise</u>. The Revegetation Industry Association of WA (RIAWA) also provides a <u>directory of members</u>.

#### **Natural Resource Management, Land Care and Grower Groups**

- Do the staff of the NRM, land care or grower group hold suitable qualifications and experience?
- Can they provide examples of other projects they have successfully established in your region?
- Do they have up-to-date software and mapping capabilities?

#### **Soil Technicians and Laboratories**

- Is the soil core technician experienced in collection and handling of samples for organic carbon and bulk density analysis?
- Is the spectrometer technician experienced in the CER requirements for the spectrographic device settings and the sampling process and analysis?
- Does the laboratory have the relevant Australasian Soil and Plant Analysis Council (ASPAC) certification and National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA) accreditation?

The <u>Estimating soil organic carbon sequestration using measurement and models method</u> requires ASPAC certification for Total Carbon method 6B2 and Total Organic Carbon method 6B3, and NATA accreditation for organic carbon, bulk density and moisture analysis. <u>ASPAC</u> and <u>NATA</u> list laboratory status on their websites.
