Conditions

A post-landing nomination must be completed and submitted immediately upon weighing each consignment of rock lobster landed from the trip. An email generated by Fish Eye containing a receipt number and consignment number for each consignment will be sent to you. A record of the receipt number must be retained for a period of 5 years.

Note: If a master elects to use Fish Eye to make nominations he must complete the full process of prefishing, pre-landing and post-landing on Fish Eye for a particular trip.

If the nomination process is commenced on CatchER you cannot switch to Fish Eye Online to complete the process for any one trip.

However, if the master commences the nomination process on Fish Eye and fails to receive a receipt number for any nomination then the master must make all nominations required for the trip using IVR and submit all records using the CDR and Holding Over book where appropriate.

Under the Management Plan, sessions must end before midnight on each day fished. When using Fish Eye Online the holding over book will still need to be completed to record each session and holding over tags used.

Instructions

1. Open the **Fish Eye** website

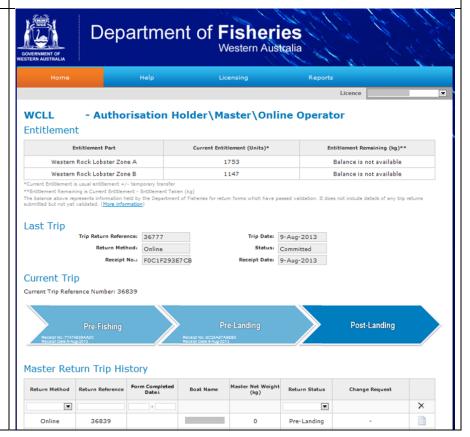
The **Log On** screen will display.

- 2. Complete the following fields:
- a) User ID
- b) Password
- c) Click the **Log On** button.

The Home screen will display with the Post-Landing chevron highlighted.



3. Click on the **Post-Landing** chevron in the **Current Trip** section to display the Post Landing nomination form.



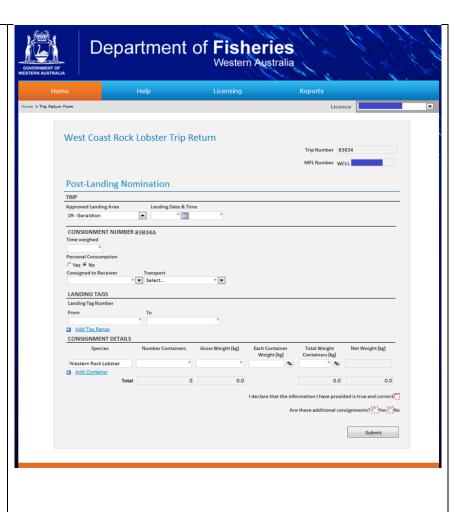
The Post-Landing Nomination form displays and a new **Consignment Number** has been generated.

- 4. Enter the details for each field.
- 5. Click on Add Tag Range if you need to add another range of tag numbers. (If you have two or more tag ranges and you wish to remove a tag range click on the range and then on the down arrow button to the left of the range. This will bring up the option to delete that range).

When you enter the Number (of) Containers, the Gross
Weight(kg) and Each Container
Weight(kg) the form will
automatically calculate the
Total Weight Containers (kg)
and the Net Weight(kg). This is
useful if your containers are a
standard weight. If you have
two sets of containers with
different standard weight you
can click on Add Container
to
enter the standard weight for
each set of containers.

However if you have a mixed range of container weights you can ignore the Each Container Weight (kg) field and just enter the Total Weight Containers (kg).

- 6. Click in the declaration **checkbox** to declare that the information supplied is true and correct.
- 7. Click in the **Yes** or **No** checkbox in answer to **Are there additional consignments?**
- 8. Click on the Submit button

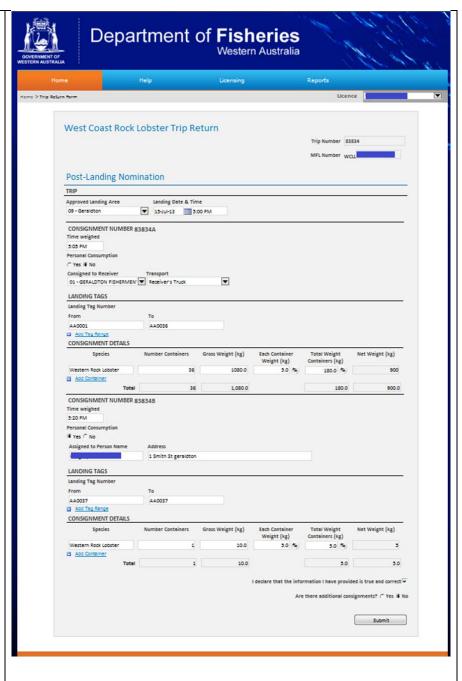


If you have clicked on **Yes** for **Are there additional consignments?** the Home screen will display with the Post-Landing chevron highlighted.

- 9. Click on the Post-Landing chevron and the Post-Landing nomination form will open with the details for the first consignment entered and a second Consignment Number generated with the same numbers as the first consignment but ending in B.
- a) Complete the details in the blank fields following the second consignment number.
- 10. Click in the declaration **checkbox** to declare that the information supplied is true and correct.
- 11. Click in the **Yes** or **No** checkbox in answer to **Are** there additional consignments?
- 12. Click on the **Submit** button.

If you have answered No to additional consignments a message will display the form has been submitted successfully and then closed and you will be brought back to the Home screen with the Pre-Fishing chevron highlighted.

13. You can log off.



You will receive an email with a receipt number. A record of the receipt number must be kept for a period of 5 years. A nomination is not valid until the receipt number issued by Fish Eye is recorded.
