How to apply

Applications open on 19 April 2024. Complete the form and submit all required documentation via the online grants portal, SmartyGrants.

Applications close at 1:00pm (AWST) on 11 July 2024.

Who can apply?

The Scheme is open to horticultural producers in the Warren-Donnelly region with a minimum annual gross turnover of \$100,000 or equivalent.

Eligible applicants will be required to commit to a cash funding contribution of 50% of their proposed activity.

What can I apply for?

State Government is interested in projects that are infrastructure related, outcomes based and can demonstrate water security.

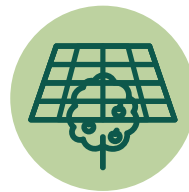
